1. You are hereby authorized to proceed as instructed by the Chief, Operations/ Security Div., Directorate of Personnel, HQ USACDC, and/or Airborne Operations Committee, Ft. Lee, Va. for temporary duty under instruction in parachutist proficiency training and operations. Approval by this command is required prior to departing for each training session.
2. No part of any expense under these orders will be paid by the Government. If you do not desire to bear the necessary expense, you will consider this authorization cancelled.
